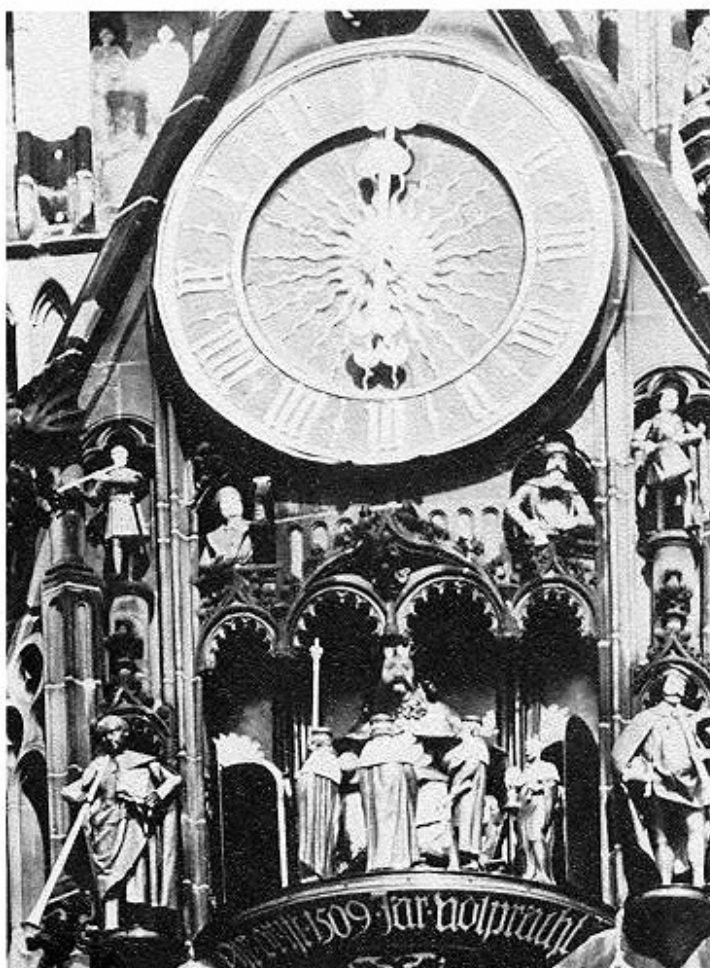
Editor's Foreword

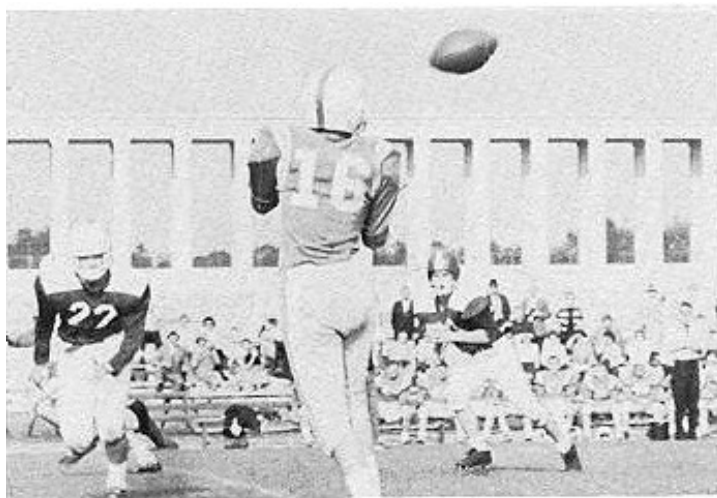
