Tough and gutty, Eagle defense held their opponents to an average of eleven points a game. The rugged offense averaged over 350 yards, and scored an average of twenty five points a game.

When the time came for All-Conference selections from the coaches, Nurnberg led the list with fifteen Eagle players filling twenty two positions. All-Europe Selections made by The Stars and Stripes, placed three Eagle players on a twenty two man squad. The three All-Europe Players were Wolf Born at guard, Ed Staats at tackle and Danny Doxtater at defensive lineback.





























Junior Class Officers


