

My Imagination

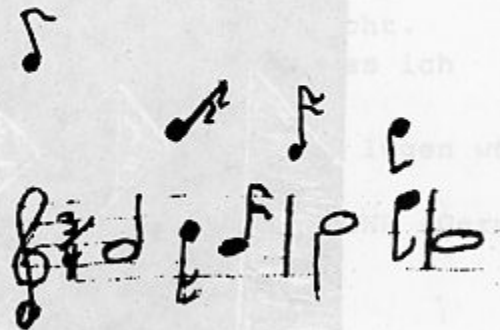
When I sleep I dream of things

Because now I'm one with Colonel Sanders. Oh well!

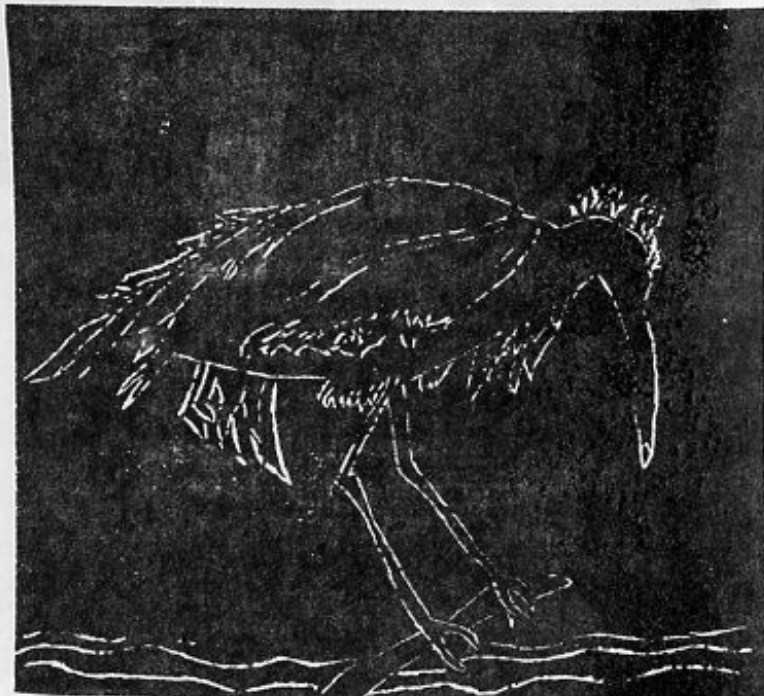
